TAKING A FLIGHT?



Effective 31st October KLM will launch services to two new Caribbean destinations: **Havana (Cuba)** and **Punta Cana (Dominican Republic)**.

After an absence of 10 years, KLM will resume scheduled services between Amsterdam and **Buenos Aires** on **October 31, 2011**.



Effective 28th November, 2011 Qatar Airways will launch to a fifth gateway in China - the western city of Chongqing.

Qatar Airways and Brazil's Gol Linhas Aéreas Inteligentes, have implemented a new code share agreement to connect travellers from Doha to 46 cities across Brazil through Sao Paulo Guarulhos International Airport



Effective January 2012, will launch daily flights to Dublin, marking its first route to the Republic of Ireland.



Commences flights to Ndola (Zambia) from 1 October 2011 three times a week. Effective 31st October, the will fly to Bujumbura (Burundi), Kigali (Rwanda) and Cotonou (Benin).



Now operate two weekly flights between Brussels Airport and Bamako (Mali) offering a total of 21 destinations on the African continent.



SWISS is to introduce daily non-stop flights between Zurich and Beijing with convenient connections out of London. The new service to China's capital, which will commence on 11 February 2012.

Unaccompanied Minor Process at Geneva

Please note that there is no lounge facility at Geneva airport. As such, the parent/guardian dropping off an unaccompanied minor has to accompany the child to the gate.

The journey to the gate crosses the **Swiss border** and therefore a passport is required by both the parent/guardian and the child.
